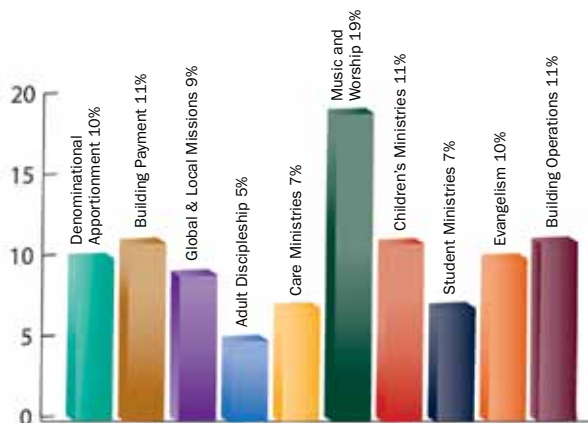

ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER (EFT)

You may give any way you choose — check or cash in the offering plate at any service you attend. We also recommend Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) as a convenient and reliable way to fulfill your financial commitment to the church. With EFT, you can reinforce your commitment to give your tithes and offerings to God first before anything else. EFT is also the most cost-efficient method of giving, reducing administrative costs and allowing ministry plans to proceed consistently throughout the year. This is especially important during the summer and at holiday times.

To choose EFT, simply complete the information on the reverse side and attach a voided check. If you have previously used EFT's, you still need to complete the Estimate of Giving Card for 2013, but you can select to use the bank account information the church already has on file for you.
