I remember him telling me, 'It is amazing how much luckier you will be the harder you work,' and, 'You cannot do it overnight. It takes a long time to be successful.' I have always believed that at one time or another everyone needs help. I received a lot of help from my Dad. In our business together, he once saw that I made a \$10,000 mistake on a bid. He did not point out the mistake to me, but he let it go. When I asked him about it later, he explained to me, 'If the mistake comes out of your back pocket, you will never forget it.' And after 37 years, I can tell you I have not forgotten it. After my Dad died, I discovered many examples of his generosity that he had not shared with me. I think that may have been the catalyst that gave me the desire to start the Bob McCaslin Memorial Fund at the Wesley Mission Center. The fund was started with part of my inheritance from my Dad and has been added to over the past 11 years. God willing, we will continue to see it grow."
